BIJA Submission Guidelines

Authors are expected to follow these guidelines while preparing article submissions for the “Rights and Law Lens” section:

- ❖ **Authenticity of Sources:**
 - Use only credible and authentic sources for all information.
 - Include hyperlinks to the sources wherever possible. (*Exception: academic journal references do not require hyperlinks.*)
- ❖ **Avoid Plagiarism and AI-Generated Content:**
 - Do not copy content from other sources. All write-ups must be original.
 - Avoid AI-generated text. If AI usage or plagiarism exceeds 15%, the submission will be rejected.
 - Researchers are encouraged to cross-check using AI and Plagiarism detector tools before submission.
- ❖ **Thematic Alignment:**
 - Ensure the write-up is strictly aligned with the topic or research focus.
- ❖ **Word Limit and Relevance:**
 - Submissions must be between 600 and 1000 words for the article.
 - Remove unnecessary or irrelevant information or arguments to maintain focus and clarity.
- ❖ **Quality of Writing:**
 - Ensure clarity, coherence, proper grammar, and readability.
 - Organise content logically with strong arguments and evidence-based reasoning.
- ❖ **References and Citations:**
 - Provide proper citations for all sources.
 - Academic journals can be cited without hyperlinks, but all other sources must include clickable hyperlinks.
- ❖ **Fact-Checking:**
 - Verify all information for accuracy and authenticity before including it in the write-up.
